### ■ How and why did you decide to study abroad?/留学を決めるまでの経緯:

I decided to study abroad during junior year as this was the most appropriate time for me to go abroad as well as figure out my future plans and if I would like to attend a graduate (PhD) program in the United States. I also identified a potential professor whose work I had read and admired and I wanted to study under her and research with her. Additionally, as a PEAK student with low Japanese language ability, I am unable to register for many interesting courses at UTokyo due to the fact that they are only offered in Japanese. While studying abroad, I could register for many interesting courses that I otherwise would not have been able to. I am bilingual so language improvement was not a concern for me. However, I was able to study Spanish during my time there and it has greatly benefitted me.

I went to JHU for a particular professor working in the field I am interested in. I was lucky enough to be enrolled in 2 classes with her over the course of the year and I was extremely impressed by the way she taught, research and organized her lectures. Her name is Dr. Erin A. Chung. I highly recommend her although she will be on a sabbatical for a year in 2019-2020. I also had the opportunity to be her research assistant and worked on some meaningful research. Hopkins has a great Political Science department and I was lucky enough to take most of my courses in this department. Their language programs are also intense but very effective.

# ■ Environment around the accommodation and how did you find it/宿泊先の様子、どのように見つけたか:

Johns Hopkins University reserves rooms in 9E 33rd for all exchange students. You live with other exchange students, mostly from Europe/Singapore. They try to keep Japanese students with European students. Single room, shared bathroom and shared apartment. The area around is very good and it is one minute walking to the main campus.

# ■ Climate, environment around the institution, transportation, food, etc./ 気候、大学周辺の様子、交通機関、食事等:

Baltimore has a MARC train and public transport, however, Hopkins has its own security vehicles and vans that are great to travel within a parameter. Additionally, many people use the service of Uber and Lyft in the US.

### ■ Management of money and situation about local economy/お金の管理方法、現地の通貨事情:

Opening a local bank account is very easy. Bank of America is very close and it is easy to make an account there by taking your student visa documents and passport. I suggest only making a debit card although they would give the option of a credit card. E-money is most commonly used via Venmo. It is essential to have an American bank account to use Venmo.

# ■Aspects of risk and safety management, local health care system, and any actions taken to maintain your health/治安、医療関係事情、心身の健康管理で気をつけたこと等、危機管理:

Healthcare is extremely expensive in the United States even with insurance. Every international student has to be enrolled in the Johns Hopkins healthcare insurance so it will be better. JHU clinic visits will be free in most cases.

### ■ Procedures for enrollment required by the host institution/留学先への入学手続き:

Online application with two reference letters. Smooth process, quick acceptance once you are recommended by UTokyo.

### ■ Procedures to obtain visas/ビザの手続き:

J-1 (Exchange Visitor) visa after obtaining DS-2019 from host university. Financial records must be submitted to obtain that. Make sure to fill out the visa application at U.S. embassy quickly to get an appointment easily and leave time for any problems. Visa appointment date came for 2 weeks later, visa processing was quick and I received the J-1 visa in about a week after going to the interview to the U.S. embassy in Tokyo.

### ■ Preparations or actions taken to maintain your health/医療関係の準備:

Pre-departure health check-up is a document you have to submit along with other medical forms for U.S. university.

It is better to go in your 3rd year 2nd semester if you are planning to go only for a semester to avoid major requirements by PEAK.

### Reflection/留学を振り返って

### ■Impact of the study abroad experience on yourself or your thoughts/留学の意義、その他所感:

I was already "studying abroad" as a PEAK student in Tokyo, however, this was the first time I studied abroad in the Western world. I became accustomed to a new culture and new values after adjusting myself to Japanese values so it was a great experience for me. After living in Asia for many years, I did find some problems with the US way of life like racism, mistreatment of foreigners and cases of discrimination as well as in Baltimore the lack of safety that was never felt in Tokyo. However, I felt that it was a good way for me to think more deeply about my learnings in both Japan and India and how to make myself more global. I was also more confident in some ways in the United States due to the fact that I felt like I fit in more there than I do in Japan as an Indian origin person. Additionally, I was more expressive in the US due to my native level language skills in English, and relieved of the restrictions Japanese sometimes puts on me due to my lack of fluency in the Japanese language.

After studying in the United States and experiencing the system there I can say that I am satisfied with the working environment there and appreciate the rich resources in my field of research that are only available there. I would be interested in applying to graduate programs (PhD) in the United

学校からの紹介で交換留学生は全員同じアパートだった。個人のベットルームがあり、キッチンとバスルームを 4 人のフラットメイトでシェアする形だった、キャンパスから徒歩 2 分程度の非常に近い好立地だった。

■気候、大学周辺の様子、交通機関、食事等/Climate, environment around the institution, transportation, food, etc.:

気候は東京とそれほど変わらず、過ごしやすかった。ボルチモアは治安が悪いが、大学周辺はセキュリティーがしっかりしていて安全だった。キャンパスから離れる際にはどのような交通機関や地区に行くべきか事前の情報収集が必要。食事は基本的に自炊、友人などと外食に時々出かけていた。

■お金の管理方法、現地の通貨事情/Management of money and situation about local economy:

現地のバンク・オブ・アメリカで口座を開設した。アメリカは venmo という無料送金サービスが普及していた。海外送金は transferwise というサービスがお得。

大学の保険の下で無料で診察が受けられたので、体調が悪い場合は積極的に利用した。しかし検査費用などは自己負担なので注意。トラベルセンターを利用して冬休みの長期旅行に向けた予防接種などを受けた。

オンラインでの申し込みで非常に簡単だった。東京での審査は予約が集中するので早めの予約が安心。

■医療関係の準備/Preparations or actions taken to maintain your health:

米国、特に Johns Hopkins は予防接種の規定が厳しかったので大学の保健センターや他の医療機関を利用して準備した。常備薬は一年間分かかりつけ医に処方してもらっていた。 Johons Hopkins 大学は保健費用が高い分予防接種は無料で受けさせてもらうことができたため、留学中に黄熱病や B 型肝炎などの予防接種をした。

東京大学必須の保険に加え、Johns Hopkins 大学必須の保健にも入らねばならずかなり費用がかさんだ。 その分留学中の医療費や予防接種費用はほぼかからなかった。
