**Extra 1: Special Course „Speaking Practice Basic“ (A2/B1)**

Teaching volume	16 teaching units / UE (1 UE = 45 minutes)	
Teaching time	Monday and Wednesday, 18.00 - 19.30 pm	
Target group	Learners who would like to conduct conversations in German and improve their oral skills.	
Language requirements	Level A2/B1 in accordance with CEFR	
Content	The focus is on free speech. To develop confidence using the spoken language, special communication tools and structures are acquired and practiced in the course.

- With the acceptance of our offer the General Terms and Conditions and the data privacy statement of the *Deutschkurse* will apply.
- ECTS credit points: Students receive ECTS credit points in case of attending the lessons at 80 % of the teaching time and in case of reaching designated results in the tests held during the lessons.
- Group assignment: Up to their level of skills the students will be allocated in one of the regularly proceeded courses of level A1 to C1. Therefore they are integrated in a cultural heterogeneous, but according to their language level homogeneous group. The assignment of the students will be done either through a significant certificate according to GER or through an online-test passed with the application.
- Please note that our intensive courses take place in the morning **or** in the afternoon. If you wish a guarantee on a morning course for the students, we charge an extra fee of 60 EUR per person per day course intensive.
- Teaching material: The courses of Modul 1:A1, Modul 2:A2, Module 3:B1 and Module 4 are formed by a book; the other courses work with house-owned, especially for the level developed material. Students, whose language level provides an allocation in Module 1, Module 2, Module 3 and Module 4 need to buy the according book (price about 30 EUR). For modules 5, and 6, a flat fee of 15 EUR per course is charged for the teaching materials.
- If a course is held as a face-to-face course, courses take place at the following locations in Munich: Agnesstraße 27, Karl-Theodor-Straße 69, rooms of the LMU München. Locations cannot be chosen individually, but are assigned by *Deutschkurse*.

- Availability via e-mail: students agree to provide an e-mail address that is valid in Germany in order to guarantee a smooth communication.
- Accommodation - arrival and departure dates:  
Check-in on 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2026; latest check-out on 28<sup>th</sup> August 2026 at 10:00 am.
- Latest day of application: **1<sup>st</sup> May 2026**
- Payment deadline: **15<sup>th</sup> May 2026**  
By paying the total fee the application becomes binding and you will receive a confirmation of payment.
- Cancellation policy:  
In case of cancellation until 31<sup>st</sup> May 2026 an administration fee of 150 EUR per person will be retained, the remaining amount will be reimbursed. In case of cancellation from 1<sup>st</sup> June 2026 the entire course fee and accommodation fee will be retained by the *Deutschkurse*. Any withdrawals have to be done in writing.
- Application and payment procedure:
  - The International Education Promotion Group of the University of Tokyo will publish the offer on its website and will inform the students and the departments/faculties of the University of Tokyo about the program in an appropriate way.
  - To enroll for the Intensive Course, please use the enrolment form on the website <https://www.dkfa.de/en/online-registration/> (select "Summer Courses" as the course type and the desired module, then select "Summer Intensive Language Course"). A copy of the valid certificate of enrolment from the University of Tokyo must be uploaded at the time of registration. To enroll online for the Special Course (Extra 1), select "Special Course" as the course type.
  - Students must also send an email to [info@dkfa.de](mailto:info@dkfa.de) with "Uni Tokyo" in the subject line, confirming that they are enrolled at the University of Tokyo.
  - Students will then receive a request for payment
